Overview

- Follow all hospital policies; including ones related to COVID-19. Your teacher will provide hospital specific details (i.e. where to enter, where to change, where to have your breaks, etc.)
- Wear your street clothes to the hospital, change into uniform and duty shoes on arrival and before leaving.
- Where possible during practice education, education or work experience, students and faculty should follow physical distancing recommendations (maintaining a distance of two metres between people). This includes adhering to distancing guidelines while on shift break, before and after a shift to decrease transmission risk.
- PPE will be provided by Interior Health.
 - This may change so remain flexible and adaptive!!
 - Expect to be required to wear a surgical mask and **approved eye protection** for the entire shift.
